

organized, centered around themes of Gandhi's life and his vision for India. The enthusiastic participation of students in these events was a testament to their respect and admiration for the Mahatma.





She highlighted Maulana Azad's vision for a progressive and inclusive educational framework and emphasized the transformative power of education in nation-building and individual empowerment.






