## G.O.Ms.No.311, Rev (Endts-I), dt.09.04.1990

## Chapter-I:

Rule-1: The TTD Board shall meet once in a month.

Rule-2: The EO - Secretary - shall convene the meeting.

Rule-4: Notice of meeting and Azenda shall be sent to the members – 7 days

before.

Rule-6: Board meeting shall be presided by the Chairman or Commissioner Endowmetns

Rule-8: The Executive Officer shall draft the proceedings of the meeting – the Chairman or commissioner shall approve –

Rule-13: The Board shall lay down general lines of policy in accordance . with Act policy matters regarding facilities to pilgrims.

- a. Transport Roads & Communications:
- b. Accommodation.
- c. Catering
- d. Protected water supply sanitation.
- e. Orderly dharshan

f. Safety person & property

g. Medical & Health facilities - Education

- h. Such other matters of policy on general

# Rule-13(3): Implementation of Board resolutions

i. The resolutions not in accordance with law.

ii. Resolutions - in excess of powers or abuse of power

iii. Resolution – if implemented causes financial loss to TTD – danger to human life, health or safety or lead to a riot or breach of peace.

iv. the above resolutions shall be placed before Board for reconsideration – if not revised shall be sent to Govt.

Rule 21 : Oath – formats – affidavit by Board members Chapter – VI: DPP

Rule-28: The TTD Board shall constitute an executive committee to DPP constituted under section 112 of Act.

- 1. Chairman of the TTD Board
- 2. Commissioner Endowments
- 3. EO, TTD
- 4. Two members from TTD Board nominated by TTD Board.

Rule 29: The Executive Committee shall co-opt not more than three members

<u>Rule-31:</u> The DPP shall meet at least once in three months – Fulltime secretary

Rule-34: The funds of DPP shall be utilized for the objects mentioned under Section-112(3) of Act 30 of 1987.

Chapter-IX: Maintenance of accounts

- Rule- 63: The FA & CAO is responsible to maintain accounts of receipts and disbursements.
- Rule-64: FA&CAO Pay & Accounts officer Cheque drawing and disbursing officer.
- Rule 65: FA & CAO shall prepare annual budget.
- Rule 66: The EO can overrule the advise of FA&CAO But he should maintain an objection book and place it before the Board every month
- Rule 73: FA&CAO shall conduct physical verification of Jewells, Vessels, Vahanams of all temples – Physical verification of other furniture's, stores, stocks etc before 30<sup>th</sup> June – shall place before TTD Board in July every year.

Chapter-XI:

Rule 76: Moneys received by TTD shall be in the custody of FA&CAO. Rule 77: The TTD money shall be deposited in scheduled banks.

Rule 79: The FA&CAO shall constitute TTD Employees pension fund, gratuity fund and provident fund – he should maintain and render proper accounts to the TTD Board. Chapter XII: Utilization of TTD funds (Sec-111 of Act 30 of 87):

Rules 82 to 88: Construction of Kalyanamandapams, Auditoriums, Geethamandhirams, schools for training of Archakas etc – loans to over seas temples – Chowltries at Various pilgrims centers – such other purposes as directed by Govt.

Chapter XVI:

Rule 116: Sale of movable properties – other than perishable goods – shall be by Public Auction.

Rule 120: TTD Board may for special reasons accord sanction for sale other than by Public Auction.

Chapter XVII:

- Rule 125: The FA&CAO shall maintained a register containing list of jewells, gold and silver vessels and other valuables (Thiruvabharanam Registers)
- Rule 127: Jewells and other valuables shall be in the joint custody of officers specified by TTD Board.
- Rule 128: Jewells and other valuables shall be under double lock system The FA&CAO shall make double lock arrangements.
- Rule 132: The EO may with permission of TTD Board make any Jewell or Vahanam for use in TTD.

Rule 136: Admission of non Hindus in to TTD Temples.

Chapter XIX: Lease of lands

- Rule 138: All leases of lands buildings and other immovable properties of TTD shall be only by Public Auction.
- Rule 146: The EO may in special cases for reasons to be recorded in writing leases otherwise than Public Auction may be granted.

Rule 147: The lease shall be for one year and may be extended up to three years.

- **Rule 150:** Leases for any number of years not exceeding 99 years on nomination by TTD Board subject to ratification by Govt.
- Chapter XXI: Gift
- Rule 157: All gifts given to or by TTD shall be with the sanction of TTD Board
- Rule 158: EO, can sanction gifts up to the value of Rs.5000/-

Rule 159: Gift of any immovable property to TTD – to be published – 30 days time.

Rule 161: Acceptance of gifts – TTD Board – up to 50 lakhs EO, Res.No.151, dt.04.10.2010.

Chapter XXII: Alienation of immovable property

- Rule 162: TTD Board shall decide Sale or exchange or mortgage of any immovable property – notice to be published.
- Rule 165: The transaction of sale, exchange or mortgage shall be sanctioned by TTD Board.
  - i. Necessary or beneficial to TTD.
  - ii. Consistent with object of TTD.
- Rule 165: The TTD Board can confirm or refuse the same with in two months

Rule 172 to 177: The TTD Board shall fix, revise, modify are cancel dhittam of any temple or institutions – to be published in News papers – 30 days time.

Rule 178: EO up to value of Rs.5000/- - delegation up to Rs.25,000/-, B5/9099/2005, dt.20.11.2009.

Rule 180: Advise of FA&CAO

Chapter XXV: Execution of works supply and servies

Rule 186: Tenders – limited tenders up to Rs.2 lakhs – Engineering Dept. – Rs.50000/- other Departments – Open Tenders above Rs.2 lakhs – Rs.50000/-

Rule 187: Acceptance of Tenders – Annexure-II & Annexure – III Chapter XXVI: Rules relating to Tirumala

Rule 196: 10 1/3 Sq. Miles around Sri TT – Exclusive property of TTD Rule 198: Sec-114 – Prohibited items.

Rule 200: EO shall have powers to prohibit or ban any political organizations and it activities

Rule 201: All private trade or business his prohibited – except with permission of Panchayath

Rule 204: All private leases and sub leases – Null and void except by permission given by EO

Rule 205: Pre emption

Chapter XXVII:

Rule 212: EO can sanction expenditure up to Rs.25,000/- for any purpose of Administration of TTD.

Rule 213: TTD Board may delegate powers to the EO.

Chapter XXVIII: Powers of EO

Rule 216: EO shall be chief Administrative Officer of TTD.

- Rule 218: He shall be responsible for proper maintenance and custody of records and properties of TTD.
- Rule 220: EO shall have power to suspend any office holder and servants of TTD
- Rule 221: EO shall fix the wages of all the employees of TTD other than those on time scale of pay.

Rule 222: EO shall regulate pilgrims for Dharshan in all temples

Rule 223: EO is responsible to preserve security, Religious and holy environment and sanctity at Tirumala and have power to issue any order for the same.
